Jodie Hollander, originally from Milwaukee, Wisconsin, was raised in a family of classical musicians. She studied poetry in England, and her poems have appeared in journals such as *The Poetry Review*, *The Yale Review*, *PN Review*, *The Dark Horse*, *The New Criterion*, *The Rialto*, *Verse Daily*, *The Best Australian Poems of 2011*, and *The Best Australian Poems of 2015*.

She is the recipient of a Fulbright Fellowship in South Africa, a National Endowment for the Humanities Grant in Italy, a Hawthornden Fellowship in Scotland, and attended the MacDowell Colony in 2015. Her debut publication, *The Humane Society*, was released with Tall-Lighthouse (London) in 2012, and her full-length collection, *My Dark Horses*, is published with Liverpool University Press (Pavilion Poetry).

She is the Poet in Residence at the Museum of Northern Arizona and will lead a workshop on our theme of Belonging, inspired by the CCC Common Read book, Sebastian Junger's *Tribe: On Homecoming and Belonging*.
