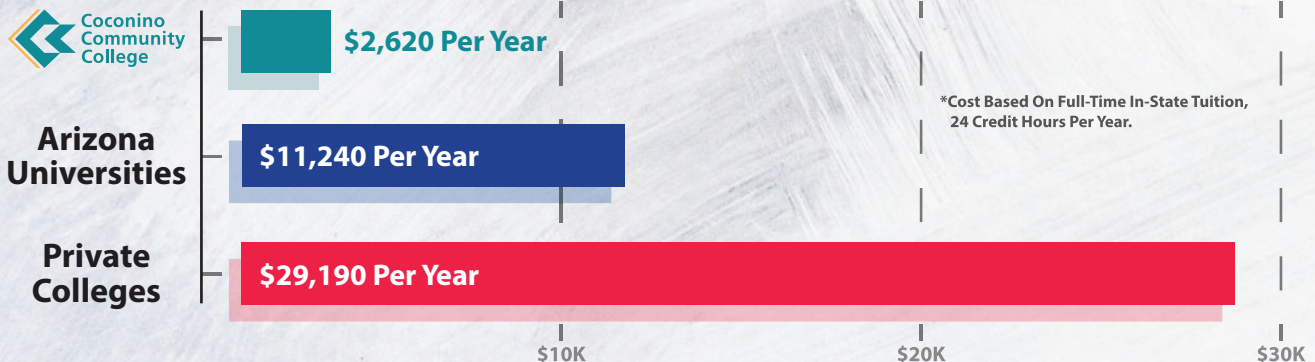
## Average Age of Students
