

President's Information Report April 2022

NOTABLE:

Tom Lehman is wrapping up his sabbatical on Cellular Physiology this spring. He surveyed anatomy & physiology educators across the country and designed a hands-on activity for students to learn and demonstrate mastery of membrane transport in various tissues. He will be presenting a poster and a hands-on workshop at the Human Anatomy & Physiology Society in Fort Lauderdale, Florida at the end of May. Students will start to use this activity in their classes in the fall.



CCC is an Arizona State Team awardee of the Career Pathways SNAP E & T Technical Assistance

Project. The award will provide technical assistance and peer learning to three states to develop or expand a Career Pathways SNAP E & T program and partnership between the state's human service agency and community college systems, intermediaries, and/or individual institutions. The primary goal is to build career pathways to advance racial equity and economic mobility by increasing access to high-quality skills training and robust career pathways.

The Native American Success Center hosted a ribbon-cutting at the Page Center. Attendees included Navajo Nation President Nez, Trustee Joey Smith, Miss Navajo Nation 2022, and nearly 100 current students, staff, faculty, and community members.



At the Page City Council meeting on April 13th, Mayor Bill Diak read and signed a proclamation pronouncing **Coconino Community College Week as April 25th – 29th, 2022**. The week coincided with the Page Center Open House and Native American Success Center Ribbon Cutting and also recognizes April as National Community College Month.

The Small Business Development Center (SBDC) Success Awards were held at the State Capitol on April 14th, recognizing award winners from 2020, 2021, and 2022. 2022 Coconino County winner, Jen Green, CEO of Strides 2 Thrive and Elevated Shredding provided a short video highlighting the work of CCC SBDC.

PARTNERSHIPS:

CCC has joined the expanded Arizona Advanced Technology Network (AATN) to expand the existing Automated Industrial Technology program across the state. Participating community colleges will share curriculum and leverage resources across partners. The initiative will help CCC create an advanced technologies curriculum that will support the advanced manufacturing sector in northern Arizona. Manufacturers across the region will be engaged to provide advice and direction on the content and structure of the programs. Existing courses will be shared across the network. A nationally

recognized framework for manufacturing standards (NAM-endorsed Skill Certification System) will serve as a central organizing feature. At the end of May, CTE Dean Lisa Blank will be touring the advanced manufacturing programs of Estrella Mountain CC and Mesa CC as part of the kick-off for this work.

Perkins funds were allocated to install an ambulance simulation rig at the Fourth Street Campus due to the paramedic program moving to CCC. Graphics on the outside of the installation soon. Students training with the Mobile Ambulance Trainer will experience the full effect of responding to calls in a variety of settings and climate conditions within the confined space of an ambulance.



Coconino Community College staff, partnering with the City of Page, held the **41**st **Page Attacks Trash Day** on April 2nd. With the help of over 400 volunteers, nearly 8,000 pounds of trash was collected!

Two different "Career Days" were held at Williams High School which focused on customer service, including a panel of hospitality employees that shared real-world experiences and advice with $10^{th} - 12^{th}$ graders. CCC also partnered with The Grand Canyon Railway in organizing a job fair and career exploration opportunity for students.
