Policy

The District Governing Board (DGB or Board) recognizes the importance and necessity for the welfare and governance of the College that Board members engage in educational and development opportunities as well as assessment and reflection. This retreat will be funded as budget allows. The retreat shall be held in compliance with the Arizona open meeting law (A.R.S. §38-431 et seq.).
