Construction Technology Management (CTM), in partnership with Extended Learning, Coconino County, the Phoenix Indian Center, and the Hualapai Tribe, completed the 9th year of the CAMT programs. This year 100% of the students in the program earned OSHA 10, EPA 608, and Certified Maintenance Technician Industry Certifications.
